# **Continuous Training Certified**

### **What is it?**

MCAS Continuous Training Certified is a program created to recognize MCAS Member Company's dedication to employee training. Member companies can receive a new certification sticker for each year that they qualify for the CTC Program.

### **How do you apply?**

There are two forms available for Company applicants to fill out: an Enrollment Form and a Course Submission Form. The Enrollment Form is submitted to the MCAS office to request entry into the program. A Course Submission Form is submitted after each course taken, with all required documentation.

### **What is the criteria for the program?**

Any company that applies for certification must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Must be an MCAS Member
- ✓ Obtain 1 credit for each 4 employees
- ✓ A minimum of 1 in every 4 courses must be an MCAS course
- ✓ Documentation must be provided to qualify

### **What are the benefits of becoming certified?**

You will receive a certification package which will include:

- ✓ Framed Certificate for display in your office
- ✓ Vehicle decals, up to 5 for each certified member, with additional available for a small fee
- ✓ Use of Continuous Training Certified logo on your website and other documentation
- ✓ Ad copy for use in your local newspaper
- ✓ Industry and Customer recognition as a leader in Continuous Training
