Since 1919 the Mechanical Contractors Association of Saskatchewan Inc. has been the voice of the Mechanical Contracting industry in Saskatchewan. Through industry advocacy, networking events, education, and services, MCAS is the only trade association focused solely on the needs of the mechanical contractor. The mandate of the MCAS is to “encourage, support, and promote the advancement of the Mechanical Contracting Industry in Saskatchewan.”

Our Mechanical Contractor membership is comprised of Plumbing, Heating, Refrigeration, Steam Fitting, Pipe Fitting and Sheet Metal trades. We recognize the industry extends beyond the contractors. Product suppliers fall into our Affiliate Member category and industry specific service providers fall into our Professional Member category. We have also established a Trade Member category for those who work alongside the mechanical trades.

The Association is governed by an elected Board of Directors representing a cross section of the industry and the province. The Executive Director, Administrative Assistant, and Member Services Coordinator carry out the mandate of the Association and respond to the needs of members.

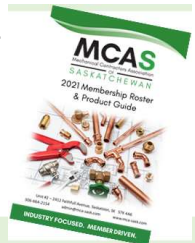

This manual is an in-shop safety program. Our basic manual has been written and approved for MCAS by a licensed Saskatchewan officer and is qualified to all Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) Standards.

MCAS Quality Control Manual

First printing: \$1250 / Renewal: \$350

A Quality Control (QC) Manual is the written description of the quality control program that address all requirements of Codes, Acts and Regulations. A QC Manual is required if the company intends to construct, install, alter or repair a boiler, pressure vessel, fitting, pressure piping system or refrigeration plants, with some exemptions. Manuals and licensing require approval from the Technical Safety Authority of Saskatchewan (TSASK).
